The BotsIQ Grant program is intended to assist in the purchase of materials for BotsIQ team(s). All participating high schools, CTCs, and qualified youth organizations (QYO) are eligible to apply. Despite the number of teams, only one grant will be awarded per school or QYO. The grant amount is contingent upon available funds and is based on the number of years the program has been active in BotsIQ. First and second year schools will receive \$1050, third years will receive \$500, and fourth and subsequent years will receive \$250.
